
#### The Rules

All names of people start with capitals
 E.g. Mohammed Ali
 As do all titles.
 F.g. Dr Watson, Sir Alec Guiness, Captain

E.g. **Dr** Watson, **Sir** Alec Guiness, **Captain** Scarlet, **Princess** Grace of Monaco, **Lady** Gaga **Mr** Smith, **Mrs** Rajzova, **Ms** Jones, **Miss** Matloob and **Master** Chadwick

- 2. All names of shops and brands start with capitals when we are writing, even if the logos don't (they do this for design reasons)
  - Sainsbury's, Marks and Spencer's, McDonald's
  - Nike, Adidas, Puma, Dolce and Gabanna, Armani

#### The Rules P.S.



Small joining words like in, of the, and etc don't need capitals : just the main words.

#### The Rules P.S.

The name of the doctor.

The doctor who saw me was called Dr Briggs.

Not the actual name of the doctor.


