# The Rules

**Sentences can only end with three types of punctuation:**

1) **Question mark** for an interrogative sentence.

E.g. How are you?

2) **Exclamation mark** for an exclamatory sentence (usually expressing strong emotions or drama).

E.g. This is disgusting!

3) A **full stop** for a declarative sentence, making a statement

E.g. I found a pen on the floor.

**The rule is simple but you would be surprised by how many students don't use the right punctuation or forget to use any at all!**

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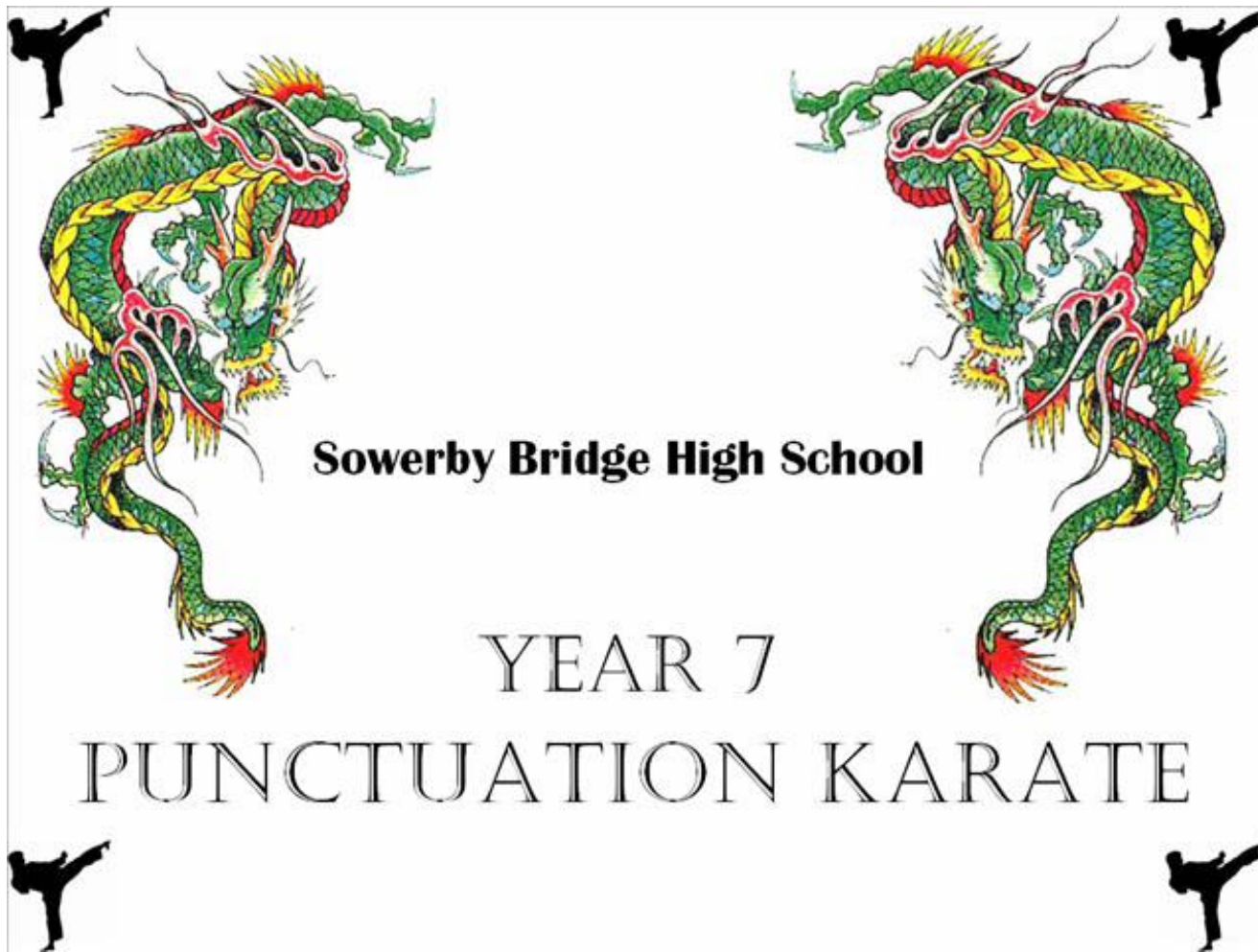
