Progress

The Marches Sixth Form achieved a progress score of +0.15 in 2016. The National Progress figure was 0. We are delighted that the Sixth Form performs well above the national average. It is significant to note that the Marches Sixth Form progress score was the highest in Shropshire when compared to other school sixth forms and colleges. The average A-level grade achieved by students in the Marches Sixth Form was a C.

Retention

Of all the students who began their A-level studies at the Marches School 93% completed their chosen courses. Those who left the school mid-year went onto vocational study or to take up apprenticeships.

Destinations

100% of the students who left the Marches Sixth Form went on to Education, Employment or Training. The vast majority went on to study at University, with a significant number taking up places at Russell Group Universities and one securing a place at St. John's College, Cambridge. Other destinations included higher level apprenticeship and one student chose to take a gap year but will be taking up his University place in September.
