SIXTH FORM DRESS CODE

Appropriate For School

For Boys

- Collared shirt / polo shirt
- Smart subdued coloured trousers
- Jumper, cardigan, jacket
- Smart shoes suitable for work, no canvas/leisure shoes or trainers

For Girls

- Smart tops which maintain modesty. Shoulders, stomach and back covered, no visible underwear
