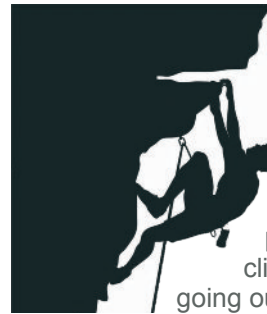
Psychology Conference
