Pastoral Exceptions

The following criteria are to be met for the next 2 weeks – that is from Monday 14th May – Friday 25th May, just 10 school days. Attendance will be counted for these 10 days only, thus current attendance will not be taken into account.

Here is the list of expectations:

- No Lates
- No 3 or 4 lesson gradings
- No Smart
- Attendance 95% or above for the period 14th May-25th May 2018
- No issues at social time

If any of these are not met, it will result in 1 extra day in grey, i.e. each 3 or 4 lesson grading gained in that time = 1 extra day in grey, each Smart signature = 1 extra day in grey. Any issues at social time = 1 extra day in grey. In the case of attendance, missing more than half a day of school would result in attendance for this period dropping below the 95 per cent mark, which would result in one extra day in grey.

Clearly there will be a need for discretion in individual cases.

Academic Expectations

You will demonstrate your readiness for Year 11 in your subject lessons by behaving appropriately, as the majority of you do every day.

For the minority who don't always get it right, usual sanctions will be applied, including receiving behaviour points, which will in turn, delay the start of the black uniform.
