Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to Year 7 students and welcome back to most year groups, with Years 9 and 10 to join us on Monday. The students are looking excellent, they have a great attitude to the term ahead and the school is a calm place to be.

Thank you for your support for the lateral flow testing, students have been sensibly arriving for this and it is going well. We continue to use the hand gel and spray in classrooms and are keeping rooms ventilated. We no longer need to keep year groups apart but have chosen to make the year group zones a permanent addition, for the many positives it has brought.

We have also retained a stagger to the end of the day, with Years 7 and 8 leaving at 2.55pm, Years 9 and 10 at 3.00pm and Year 11 and Sixth Form at 3.05pm

Teaching staff have been in school from Tuesday this week, preparing for the student's return – and I have been reminded through these days what an excellent teaching team we have here – dedicated to working with the students to get the best from them and to raise their expectations and aspirations for themselves. It is an exciting year ahead and we are delighted to get going.

Covid isolation and illness

The current guidance is that anyone with a positive lateral flow test or PCR test, should stay at home. Please keep us in the loop using the absence line.

Students under 18 years and 6 months, and students over 18 years and 6 months who have been fully vaccinated for at least 14 days, or are not able to get vaccinated for medical reasons, do NOT need to isolate now if they are a close

contact to someone with a Covid infection.

Symptoms of Covid remain – a high temperature, a new, continuous cough and a loss or change of sense of smell or Taste. Students with these symptoms – even if mild – should stay off and arrange a PCR test.
