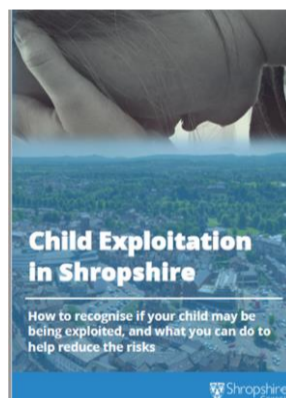
Beaver Research!
