Physics Olympiad Success

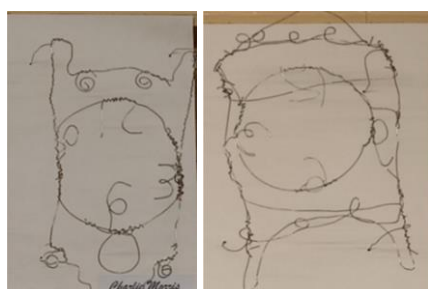
Three Year 13 students did the Physics Olympiad before Christmas (organised by Mrs Williams) and their results are in; 2 silvers and a bronze which is amazing.

Robbie Ackerman and Finley Taylor won silvers, whilst Efan Smith won a bronze.

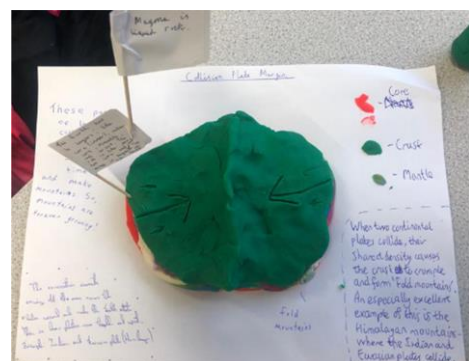
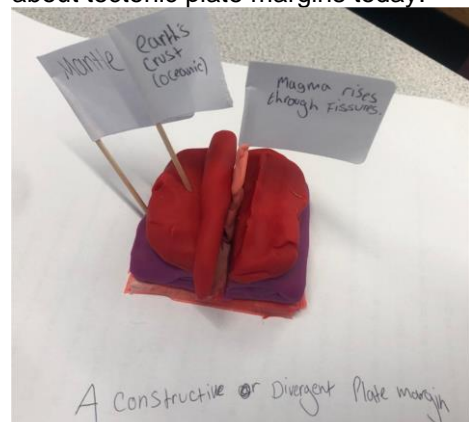
Year 7 Wire Drawings
