Media Studies at A Level will ask you to think critically about the way the mass media communicates with society, the different ways in which we might react and how the industries that make these products operate.

## What will I study?

We look at media institutions and how they are operated, what they produce (newspapers, websites and programmes) and analyse the audiences they are aimed at. You will learn how to tackle difficult theoretical issues and must be willing to read up on current media issues and debates, produce quality practical coursework and write coherent and analytical essays.

## What career and university options can it lead to?

Media Studies complements many other subjects such as Film Studies, English, Sociology and Psychology as well as Art, Photography, Performing Arts, Theatre Studies and Dance.

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
