Option 1 - Please call the school absence line no later than 8.30am, 01691 664400 (Option 1), leaving a message stating your child's name, tutor group and a brief explanation of the nature of the illness. A call is requested for every day of absence unless you have spoken directly with the Attendance Officer.

Option 2 - Email the Attendance team by no later than 8:30am at: marattendance@mar.mmat.co.uk

**Option 3 – coming soon** – a WhatsApp number to share your child's absence on.

Attendance is key to your child's outcomes in school. The overall absence rate of students not achieving Grade 9 to 4 is over twice as high as those achieving Grade 9 to 5 (8.8% compared to 3.7%).
