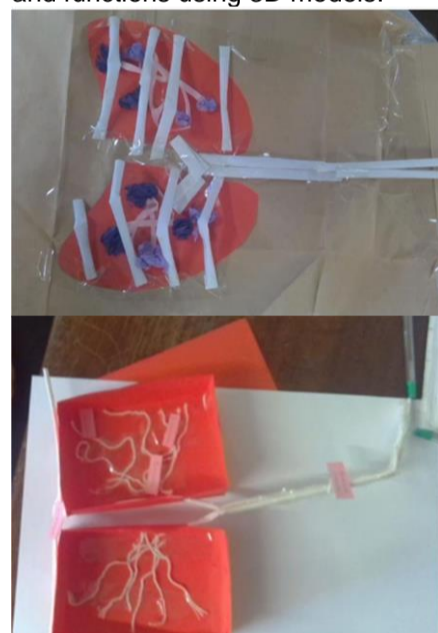
Year 10 Count the Bubbles
