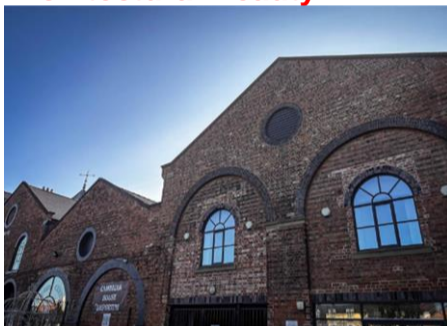


Year 7 Barcelona Project
