Living Our Values

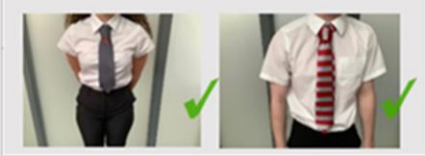

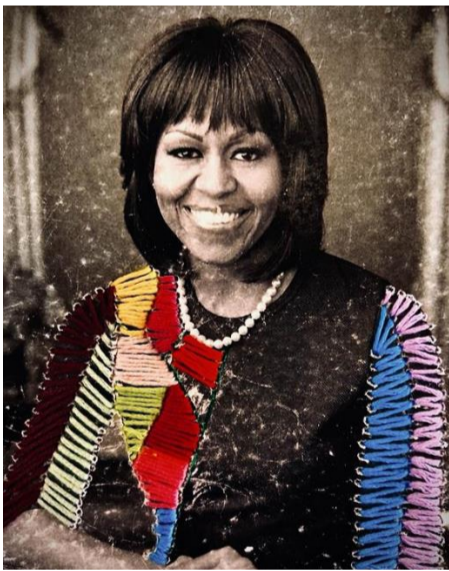

Finished the season strong beating Wrekin College 7-6 on aggregate after home and away matches.

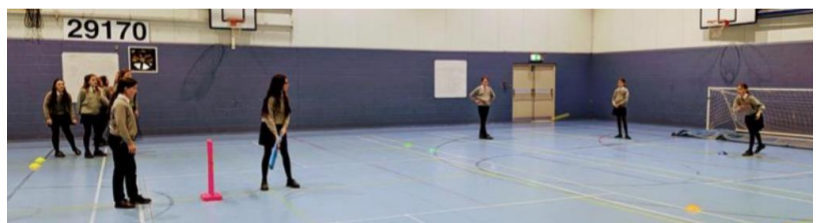
