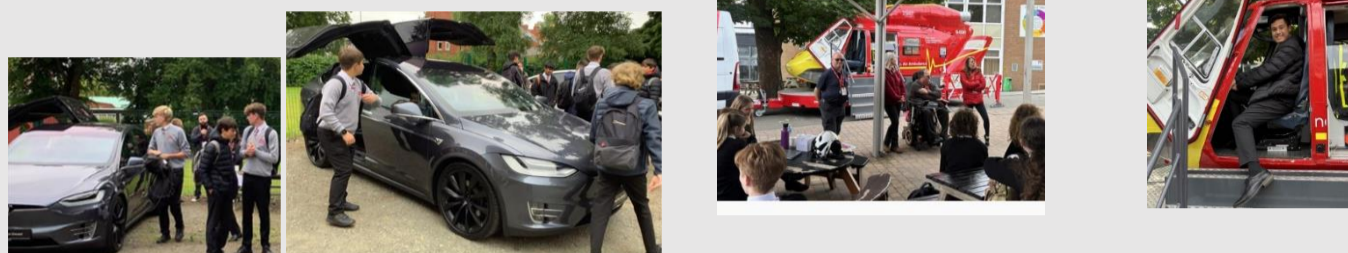


### Dear Families,
