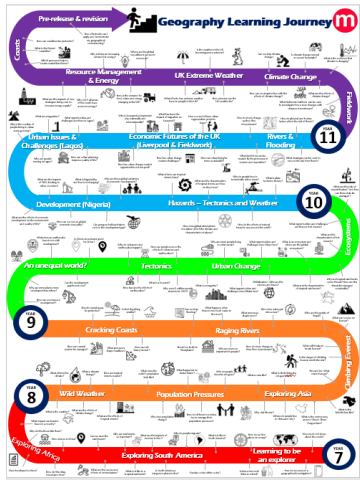
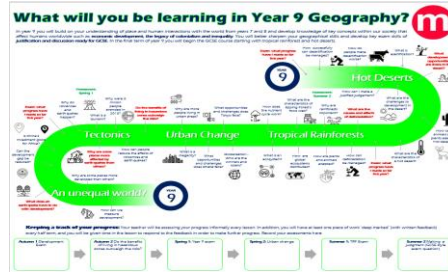


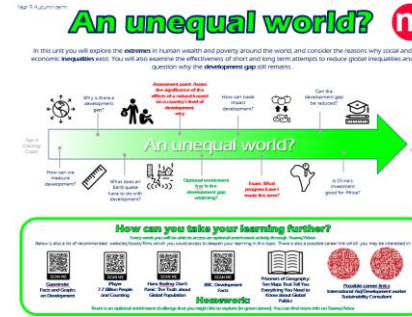
Learning journeys – in every subject. These tell you what is learnt through the whole course. They are on the website and on walls in classes.

How we share information with you

The Arbor Parent App gives you real time information on timetables, lesson gradings, attendance and allows you to see the latest reports.



Parents' Evening is the chance to talk to each teacher to discuss how things are going. All year groups have one a year. Year 7,11,12,and 13 have two a year.



Assessments take place regularly. This will often be on yellow paper. Lessons may include your child having the chance to build on this work – so you may see second drafts or edits.

The parent bulletin and Website gives you information about upcoming events and what is going on in the school.



An **Attainment Report** is shared at the start of the Spring and Summer term in Key Stage 4 and for all years at the start of the spring term. To support Options, Year 9 also get this at the start of Spring term.
