Key term	Definition
Multi-role	When one actor plays many different characters in the same play, using quick changes.
Script	The written story of a play, with all the words actors say and stage directions.
Breaking the 4 th Wall	When an actor talks directly to the audience, like there's no invisible wall between them.
Set	The scenery and furniture on stage that create the place where the story happens.
Props	The small items actors use on stage, like a cup, a book, or a toy.
Epic Theatre	An exaggerated type of theatre that doesn't pretend to be real life. It is aware of <u>it's</u> audience.
