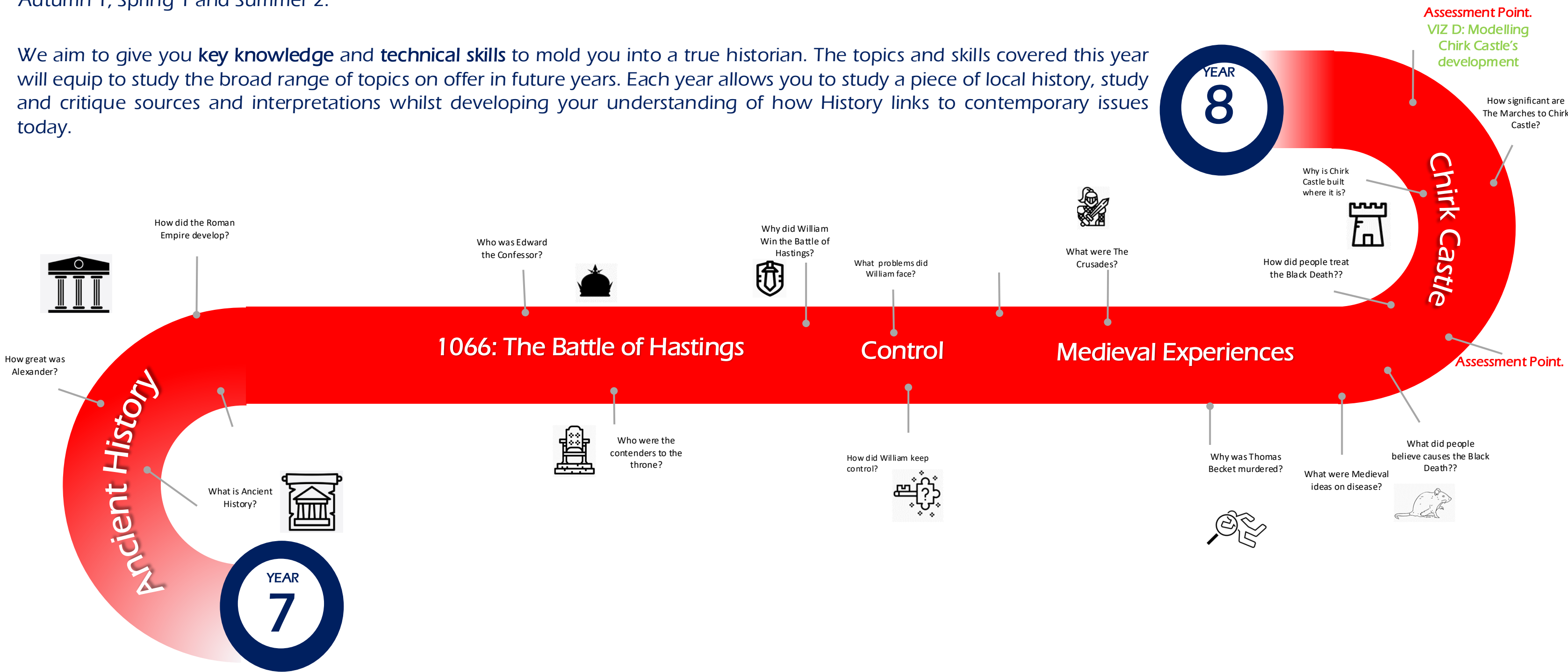


What will you be learning in Year 7 History?



In your first year of History at the Marches, you will be learning what it takes to become a true historian. The topics you will study are designed so that you cover historical topics in both **breadth and depth**. You will have the opportunity to **investigate sources** of events **justifying** deciding your **own views**. Our views in History are always changing and there is always something new to learn, especially on our **local history** as well as our **national history**. We aim to help you understand where we in our local area, fit into wider historical events. We want you to be **observant** and **critical of sources** and other **opinions** whilst building on key themes in History such as **chronology, causes and consequences**.. You will be assessed via an exam during Autumn 1, Spring 1 and Summer 2.

We aim to give you **key knowledge** and **technical skills** to mold you into a true historian. The topics and skills covered this year will equip to study the broad range of topics on offer in future years. Each year allows you to study a piece of local history, study and critique sources and interpretations whilst developing your understanding of how History links to contemporary issues today.
