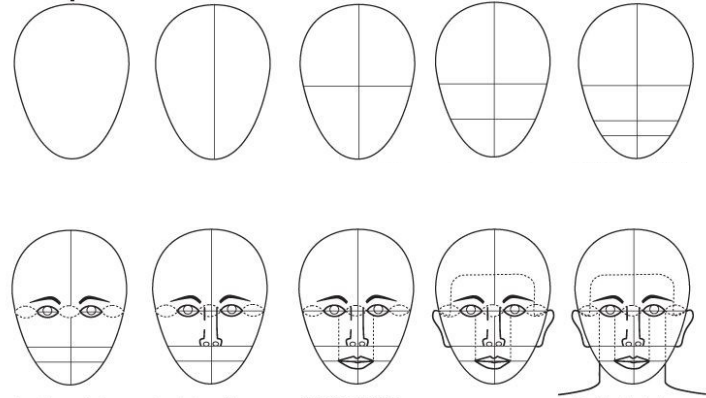


Key term	Definition
Analysis	Examining an artist's techniques, themes, & influences to understand their work's meaning and impact.
Observational Drawing	Drawing what you see right in front of you, paying attention to details & how things look.
Mark - Making	The process of creating different lines, dots, patterns, & textures by using different types of strokes and marks.
Weight of line	How thick or thin a line is. Different line weights can create emphasis, show depth, & add interest to the piece.
Portraiture	The art of creating portraits, which are representations of people, capturing their likeness, personality & mood.
Proportion	Proportion in drawing means how big or small different parts of something are compared to each other. It helps make sure everything looks right and balanced in your picture.
Scale	Scale in drawing means how big or small something is compared to other things or the whole picture. It helps make sure everything looks right and fits well together.
Features	Features in drawing refer to the distinct parts of an object or figure, such as the eyes, nose, mouth & ears on a face. Paying attention to features helps make your drawing more detailed & realistic.
Chiaroscuro	A technique where you use strong contrasts between light and dark to make things look three-dimensional & more realistic.
