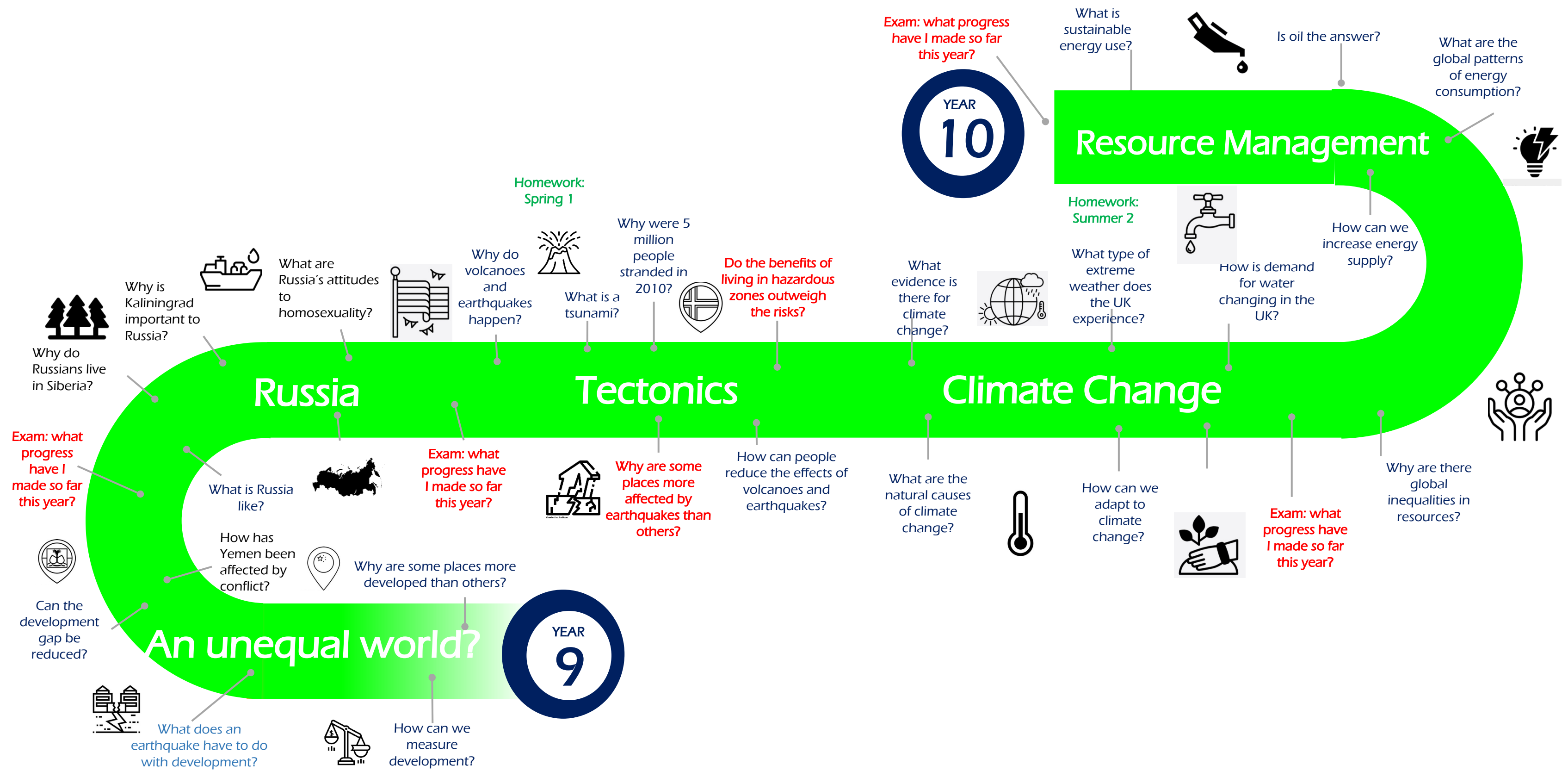


# What will you be learning in Year 9 Geography?



In year 9 you will build on your understanding of place and human interactions with the world from years 7 and 8 and develop knowledge of key concepts within our society that affect humans worldwide such as **economic development, the legacy of colonialism and inequality**. You will better sharpen your geographical skills and develop key exam skills of **justification and discussion ready for GCSE**.
