

<b><u>Key Term</u></b>	<b><u>Definition</u></b>
Philosophy	Thinking deeply about big questions in life, like “What’s right?”
Human Rights	Basic things everyone should have.
Discrimination	Treating someone unfairly.
Moral Duty	Something you feel you <i>ought</i> to do because it’s the right thing.
Conscience	The little voice inside that tells you if something is right or wrong.
Egoism	Only caring about yourself and what’s best for you.
Authority	Someone who has power to make rules or decisions
Personal Identity	What makes <i>you</i> special and different from everyone else.
Obedience	Doing what you’re told by someone in charge.

## Plato's Cave

People are **chained in a cave**, seeing only **shadows** and thinking they're real.

One person **escapes** and sees the **real world**, understanding the shadows were illusions.

When they return, the others **don't believe them**.

**Meaning:** Shadows = illusions, outside world = truth. **Lesson:** think for yourself and seek
