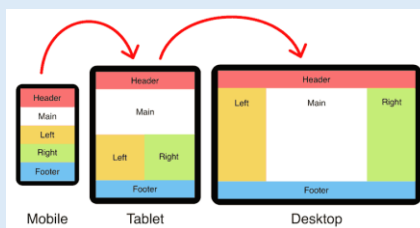

Key term	Definition
HTML	The standard language used to create web pages. (Hyper Text Markup Language) Master Page: A template that provides a consistent layout
Interactive Object	An element on a web page that users can interact with (e.g., buttons, forms).
Hyperlink	A clickable link that takes you to another web page or resource.
Banner	A large image or graphic at the top of a web page, often used for advertising or branding.
Roller Image	An image that changes when you hover over it or click on it.
Navigation	The system that allows users to move around a website (e.g., menus, links).
Consistency	Ensuring that the design and layout of web pages are uniform across the site.
Web Browser	A software application used to access and view websites (e.g., Chrome, Firefox).

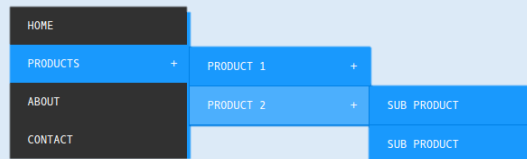
